



## Sixth Form Dress Code

**At Kineton High School Sixth Form, all students are required to wear a lanyard and photo ID card at all times - students will be required to leave their mobile phone as a deposit for a temporary lanyard.**

### General

- Hair styles and colours must be subtle and 'office-appropriate'
- Make-up can be worn, however should be minimal and discrete
- Students can wear jewellery, however facial piercings should also be discrete

### Girls

- Basic top or shirt/blouse - no strappy tops or crop tops/see through/low cut etc
- Smart blazers/jumpers are preferred – no sweatshirts or large branding
- Skirts and dresses must be worn at a reasonable length
- Tights are preferred to bare legs
- Fabric/leather smart shoes only - no sandals, trainers or pumps
- No jeans of any kind - smart trousers only
- No denim or leather look - this includes shirts, skirts or jackets
- No hoodies are to be worn around the school or in the Sixth Form Area

### Boys

- Smart collared shirt which must be tucked into a waist band
- Plain collared polo shirts may be worn in warmer weather. Must be paired with smart trousers and shoes
- Blazer and/or smart knitted jumper preferred - no sweatshirts or large branding
- Smart trousers - no jeans of any kind
- Smart business like shoes - no trainers
- No denim - shirts or jackets
- No hoodies or sweatshirts are to be worn around the school or in the sixth form area

**Students who fail to meet this dress code will be seen by Miss Loveridge and given a warning, these warnings will be monitored; on the third warning you will be sent home to change into appropriate uniform.**
