Dear Parents/Carers

KOBs (Kinerton Obstacles) Sponsored Walk/Run – 10th October 2018

This year we are planning to hold our “KOBs Sponsored Walk/Run” event on the 10th October. The event is to raise funds to improve our school environment. The event has not been held for a number of years but is always enjoyed by the students and staff alike, and we hope that this year will be as successful as previous years.

KOBs is going to involve a number of obstacles that students will have to negotiate as they go around the course. We are hoping to have a water slide, so students wishing to use this may need to bring a change of clothing. The day will be a non-uniform day and students will need to pay £1 to wear their own clothes. The KOBs course will involve some physical exertion so it will be advisable that students come prepared with footwear and clothing that will be suitable, further guidance will be given during the week.

Students are sponsored for the number of laps of the KOBs course that they are able to complete in the time period (approximately 2 ½ hours that is, period 4 during lunch and period 5). Stalls and entertainment are organised by the Sixth Form and students are charged a small amount to take part in these activities. The dining room will operate a limited service.

The Sixth Form would welcome any help you could offer with the events or with prizes. If you can provide any help in any way, then please contact us via the school office.

Attached is a sponsor form so that students can start to collect sponsorship for the day. In the interest of student safety please make sure only ‘known to yourself’ people are approached.
