This convention brings together universities and colleges within the UCAS scheme to inform and guide prospective university and college students. The events play a vital part in helping applicants decide about what and where to study within higher education. Exhibitors also include further education colleges, GAP Year organisations, student support services, professional bodies, student travel firms and advisors on student finance. In accordance with our charging policy, in order for the activity to take place we require a voluntary contribution of £10.00 from each participant. The preferred method of payment is via Parentpay.
