Dear Parents/Carers,

As we come to the end of the Summer term, I would like to say thank you for the continued support you have shown throughout the year. Before we break up for the holidays I would like to remind you of the uniform standards from September so that all students return in the full and correct dress.

Key Changes

1. Skirts. The new black pleated school skirt is the only skirt students should wear and should be purchased from our supplier SWI www.swidtp.co.uk. The old black straight style skirt is no longer part of the school uniform and should not be worn. Students can also wear black trousers if they do not wish to wear a skirt.

2. PE Kits. All students should have the new PE kit which comprises of a short sleeved red training shirt (t-shirt), black shorts and red and white socks. Girls have the option of wearing a skirt instead of shorts if they wish. Again, items should be purchased from our supplier SWI, where there are other optional sportswear items that can be purchased.

Reminders

1. Shoes. All students must wear black school shoes and not trainers. If there is a medical condition that requires trainers to be worn, please contact your child's form tutor or Head of House.

2. Piercings. Students are permitted to wear one small plain stud in each ear lobe. Please be aware that if students are wearing more than one stud or an inappropriate stud they will be asked to remove it. Nose studs and any other piercings are not allowed and students will be asked to remove these if worn.

3. Hoodies and Sweatshirts. These are not to be worn in school and this includes sweatshirts worn under blazers. Students are allowed to wear a plain black v neck school jumper over their shirt if they wish.

4. Hair and Make-up. Students are not permitted to have extreme hair styles and colours. Make-up should not be worn or should be kept discreet and minimal.

We are grateful for your support in ensuring all our students wear the correct school uniform.
